Protocol

Protocol is based on knowledge of human relationships. These relationships, particularly official ones between countries, have come to be directed by a sequence of accepted rules and procedures. They reflect the reciprocal respect and consideration between two parties. It makes possible the transcending of national boundaries and opinions in an atmosphere of courtesy and civility. When talking about protocol, the focus usually goes to the Vienna Convention and international relations. However, protocol goes beyond strictly diplomatic relations.

Diplomacy

This conference offers a brief history of protocol and its main practices. It underlines the importance of understanding protocol as inherent part of diplomacy. It also explains the difference between the various forms of protocol and helps participants to understand why key concepts such as protocol, etiquette and ceremonial are interdependent, but not reducible to each other.
